**Description of research lines:**

The purpose of the interdisciplinary research group is to define strategies aimed at enhancing

communities and implementing initiatives that can support and nurture the building of neighborly relationships. ps. The research group aims to deepen, through the approach of co-design and bottom-up practices the issues of social innovation, urban regeneration, production, commons, and places of care, and to consolidate and implement the network of entities and associations promoting on the topics of interest.

Considerations related to the loss of identity of places, the fragile presence of manufacturing traces, and the impossibility of transferring technical culture to local communities due to the relocation of production to peripheral areas, prompted a discussion on the possible paradigm shift in the functions of the city, in the belief that manufacturing realities can give rise to a neighborhood economy, and also initiate processes of reuse, recycling and invention at the basis of the circular economy. The experiences conducted, involving communities in events, debates, projects, and social initiatives of integration and training have made possible critical reflections on urban policies, neighborhood regeneration actions, and the opportunity for innovation generated by sustainable models of urban production. Urban regeneration interventions are often designed without effective community involvement and based on “standardized and homogenizing” actions.

Therefore, in the face of the increasing touristification and homogenization of urban centers, the increasingly evident conflict between phenomena of “green” regeneration and the expulsion of the weaker segments of the population, the interdisciplinary approach of the research group aims to promote a culture of regeneration that, by combining local and expert knowledge and relying on codesign pathways, fosters place-based development models, based on the re-activation of territorial capital and the active involvement of local communities.
